We use the following companies for recycling:

Enva - Hazardous garage waste. NMR and Gibbs - scrap metal. Biffa – General waste. Biffa – Cardboard, paper and wood.

In addition, all IT equipment is recycled.

Our waste management policy is driven by our commitment to reduce, re-use and recycle.

The performance of our Environmental Management System is reviewed annually to ensure on-going improvement is achieved. Ernest Doe and Sons Limited monitors and measures its impact on the environment.

We are committed to:

- Informing all of our employees on environmental issues.
