A LITTLE HISTORY WHERE IT ALL STARTED

In 1898 Ernest Doe signed a lease on a blacksmith shop near Maldon in Essex. The business in those days consisted mainly of shoeing horses and repairing agricultural machinery. In the early 1900's the business prospered and moved into selling and repairing agricultural tractors to include Fordson, David Brown, Allis Chalmers and Case.

Innovation At Ernest Doe, we consider ourselves innovators and forward thinkers and this was certainly the case in the late 1950's when local farmers were crying out for more powerful tractors to work the heavy land. In 1959, Ernest Doe launched its own tractor, The Doe Dual Drive (known affectionately as the Doe Triple D). This tractor was the coming together of two Fordson Super Majors, minus their front wheels but with a turntable slung

between them. This created a four-wheel drive, articulated tractor which, at 100 horsepower, was twice the horse power as any other tractors on the market at the time. Several hundred were built between 1957 and 1968 at our Ulting Head Office and they were shipped all over the world.

We have been involved in the construction machinery business since the 1950's. In the early days we imported from Sweden a cable

operated excavator which we called the Doemobile and at the time we also sold JCB excavators.

In 1965 we became a distributor for the Ford industrial range which then led us to selling all types of construction equipment to include Hyundai in the 1990's and more recently Thwaites, Bomag, Epiroc and Atlas Copco.

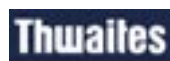

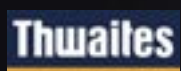

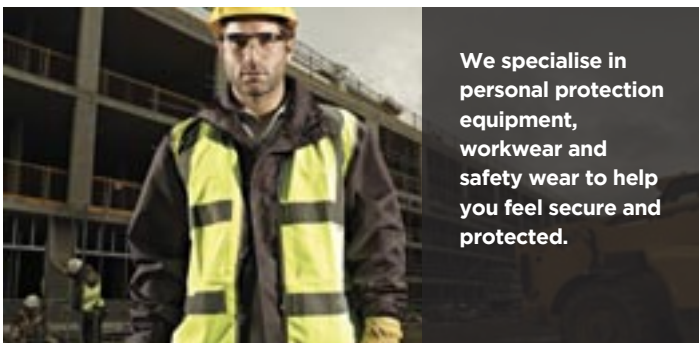
